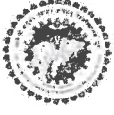

1. An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification in the concerned discipline/subject and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research papers published in reputed journals with NAAS rating 4.0 or above.
2. A Master's degree in the concerned discipline/subject with at least 55% marks or equivalent grade from a recognized University/Institute.
3. Basic Bachelor's Degree in concerned subject. In case of Veterinary faculty, registration in VCI/State Veterinary Council is essential.
4. Ten years experience in Teaching, Research and Extension in the concerned subject/field in a recognized University/Institute, out of which, at least 2 years should have been spent in a position not below the rank of Associate Professor/equivalent post.
5. The study leave taken by the candidates to acquire Ph.D. degree and/or M.Phil. shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further, the period of active service spent on pursuing research degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment.

3. Basic Bachelor's Degree in the concerned subject with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade from a recognized University/Institute. In case of Veterinary faculty, registration with a State Veterinary Council / Veterinary Council of India is essential.
4. 8 years of Teaching/Research/Extension experience in a recognized University/Institute in the capacity of Assistant Professor or equivalent.
5. The study leave taken by the candidates to acquire Ph.D. degree and/or M.Phil. shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further, the period of active service spent on pursuing research degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment.
6. To become eligible for interview, candidate of open category has to score minimum 50% marks and candidates of SC and ST category have to score 45% marks in the prescribed score card excluding the marks allotted for viva voce.

2. Basic Bachelor's Degree in the concerned subject with at least 55% marks or equivalent grade from a recognized University/Institute. In case of veterinary faculty, registration in VCI/state veterinary council is essential.
3. NET in concerned subject is compulsory along with one publication in referred journal with NAAS rating 4.0 or above in the disciplines/subject.

Essentiality of NET can be waived off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations, 2009 and the candidate has at least two full-length research papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.


1. Age Limit: -
 - (i) The age shall not be more than 35 years for the post of Assistant Professor. Upper age limit shall be determined as on the last date for submission of application as mentioned in the Advertisement. Relaxation in upper age limit to ST/SC/OBC and women and Divyang (Differently abled) candidates will be provided as per C.G. Govt. Rules.
 - (ii) For Assistant Professor or equivalent post, there will be no upper age limit bar for the regular employees/officers of the Dau Shri Vasudev Chandrakar Kamdhenu Vishwavidyalaya, Durg.
 - (iii) Permanent/temporary/contractual employees of government of Chhattisgarh or any undertaking of government of Chhattisgarh will be entitled for age relaxation as per government rules.
 - (iv) As per the order of Govt. of Chhattisgarh the upper age limit for the bonafide resident of Chhattisgarh will be 40 years. However, the age should not be above 45 years including all relaxation as per Govt. rules.
2. 4. Reservation will be available for Divyang applicants as per C.G. Govt. rules only after production/enclosure of certificate from competent authority.

SOP for domain knowledge examination for recruitment of Assistant Professor/Assistant Librarian

Important Instructions for the Candidates

On the day of interview, candidates eligible for the posts of Assistant Professor (as notified by the Vishwavidyalaya after scrutiny and scoring of application forms) shall have to appear in a written examination for evaluation of domain knowledge of the candidate.

Candidates must bring the following documents on the day of the examination at the test centre. Candidates who will not bring these will not be allowed to appear in the examination.

- Any one of the authorized Govt. photo IDs (original, valid and non-expired), viz. PAN card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)
- The candidates shall report at the Examination Centre at the time specified by the Vishwavidyalaya.
- Registration desk will close 20 minutes before the commencement of the examination. Candidates shall not be permitted to enter the Examination Centre after the gate closing time specified in the guidelines issued by Vishwavidyalaya.
- If a candidate does not report in time due to any reason such as inclement weather conditions/train/bus delay, traffic jam, etc, he/she is likely to miss the examination. No request (made by the candidate) under any circumstances shall be entertained for allowing him/her to appear in examination after the designated time. Vishwavidyalaya cannot be held responsible for such delays/events.
